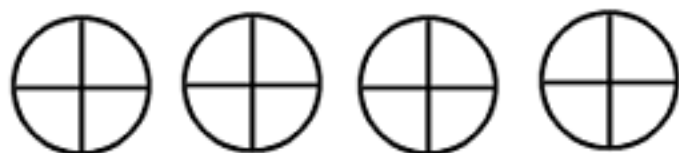

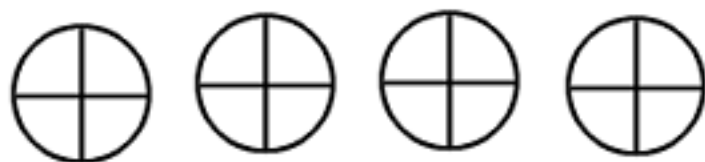
The god Odin has two ravens (*Corvus corax*).

How many sunwheels do you see here?



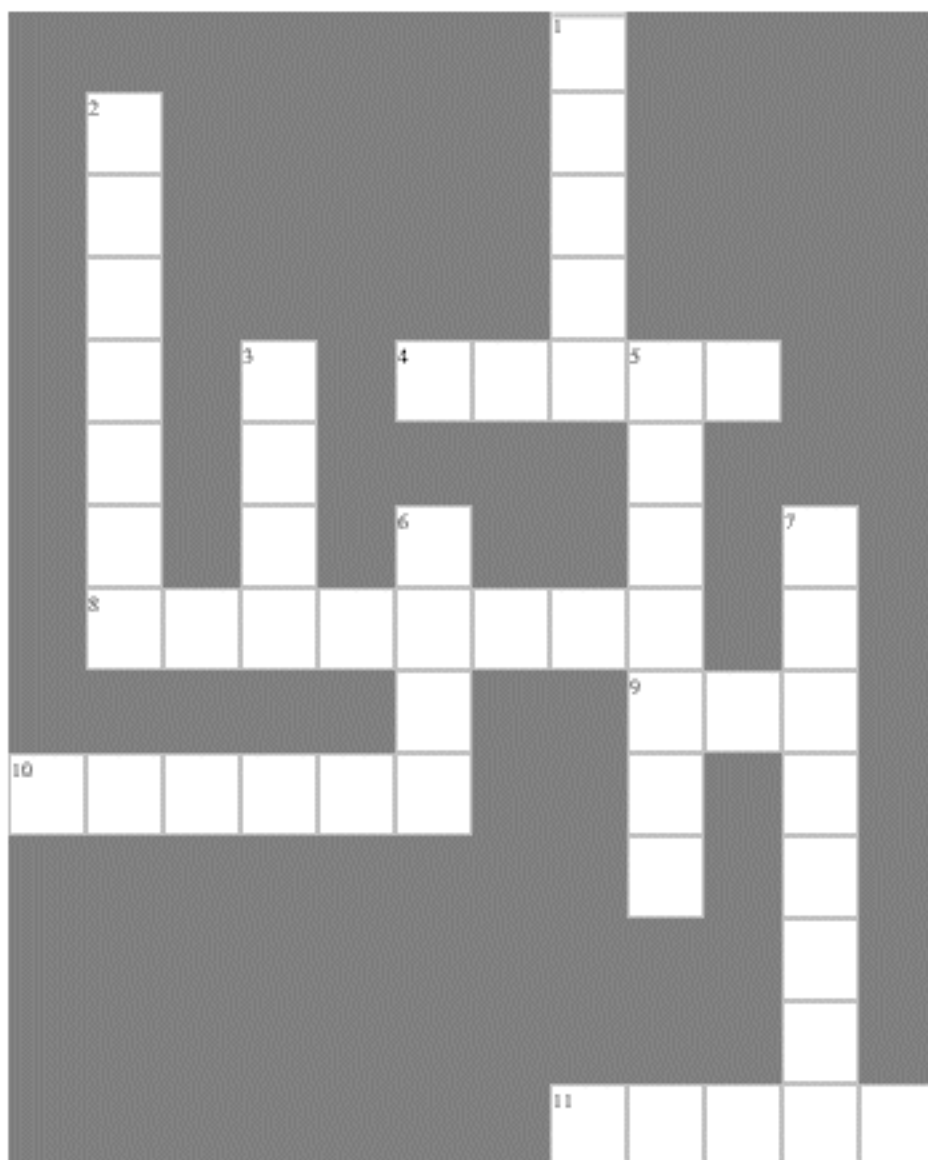

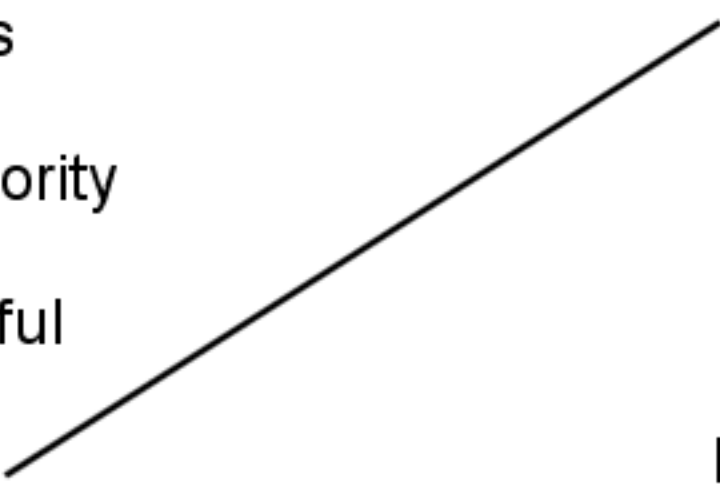
